4yo Update

The four year old programs are built on the foundation that children are capable, independent and driven learners. We support their separation from their parents and carers and build on their understanding of being part of a group, community and the world. We take the children out into their community and collaborate with them in their journeys of discovery.

Whilst we have reciprocal relationships with the 2 local schools that support the children in their transition to structured education, we celebrate the children being 4 – their unique emerging personalities, learning styles and interests.

The children have spent their first term learning routines, becoming familiar and comfortable with their educators and peers, developing their independence skills and sharing their interests and skills. A highlight has been the trip to the Briars Enviro Fest – the foundation of our sustainability program.

The children take part in weekly piano sessions, regular cooking experiences and a wealth of fine and large muscle work, creative arts and practical skill practice.

Whilst each group is unique and its programs are designed around their particular needs, the three teachers work together to a common aim, ensuring every child has a unique, expansive and wonderful learning journey at kinder.

Did You Know...

- We use Storypark to involve you in your child's learning. Storypark is a secure online communication tool used for documenting your child's learning.
- We are a nut-free centre. No nuts or nut products should be brought to preschool under any circumstances.
- Lunch boxes and drink bottles should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- We promote healthy eating habits. Your child's snack and lunch should be nutritious, filling and quick to eat.
- We are a Sun Smart preschool. Please ensure your child has a hat and apply sunscreen before arriving.
- Our programs are designed using the Victorian Early Years Learning Development Framework and are based on the 5 key areas of Identity, Community, Wellbeing, Learning and Communication.
- All of our staff hold Early Childhood qualifications and undertake regular professional development.



3yo Update

The three year old program aims to support the children to separate from their parents and carers; become familiar with and confident in their preschool environment, become familiar with peers and being part of a group, and start to share resources, space and time with their peers. The session routine is predictable to assist the children's comfort in their program – they work inside, have snack, work outside, have lunch, a rest time, a story then it's home time. Most children are separating confidently from their families and are enthusiastically exploring their environment.

The children have been exploring different ways to learn about colours by matching, sorting and playing games to identify colours.

We have been focusing on providing many opportunities for the children to strengthen and develop their fine motor skills with activities such as playdough, threading, cutting, pasting, hammering and drawing.

The children are enjoying pretend play in the home corner, sea creatures, puzzles, fire engines, sensory play, the matchbox cars and garage and the fire station Duplo is very popular floor play.

The children are learning the 'Rainbow Song' and we have been learning some action songs such as 'Where is Thumbkin', 'Head, shoulders, knees and toes' and 'Open shut them'.
